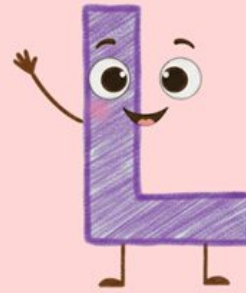
First practice tracing these curved lines.



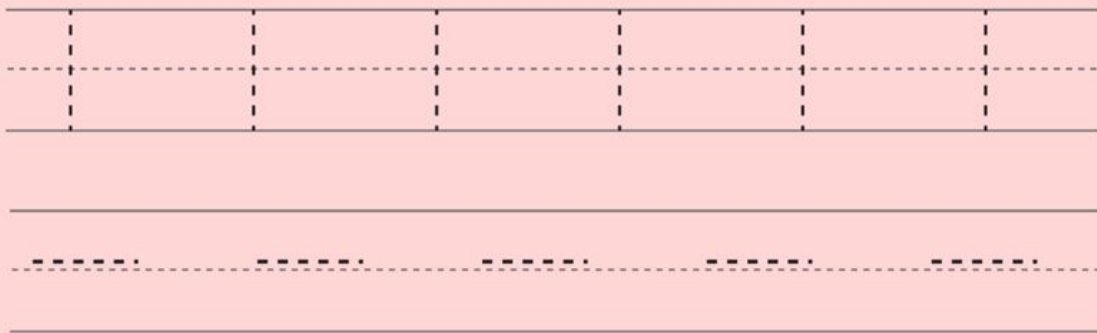
Then, trace the letter J.



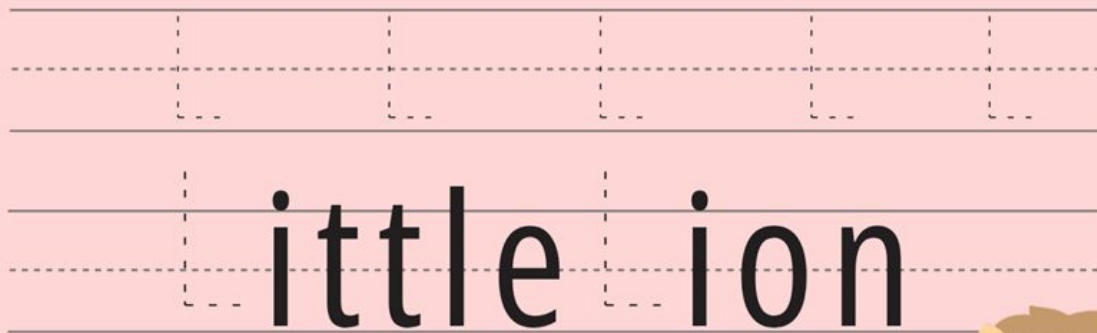
